HISTORY OF THE BARANGAY

Barangay Del Pilar was formerly a vast forestland inhabited by Negritoes. Del Pilar was a former Sitio of Barangay Villamor when Cabarroguis was not yet created as a Municipality. In 1972, by virtue of Republic Act 5554, the Municipality of Cabarroguis was created as Provincial Capital of the Province of Quirino. On the same year, Sitio Dallapan became a barangay called DEL PILAR in honor of Mayor Anastacio Dela Peña.

Since it was created, eight (8) Barangay Chairman have served the barangay as follows:
