

In 1971, Calaocan was once a sitio of Ifugao Village, a Barangay of Diffun, Quirino. This sitio was named Taltal. The word "taltal" was derived from the Ilocano word "tallo" which means Three that represents the three households who were living in the place that time. The residents often go down to the town proper of Cabarroguis to buy their immediate needs since Sitio taltal is nearer to Cabarroguis than Diffun.

A year later after the declaration of Martial Law, the residents of the sitio and nearby sitios headed by the older folks agreed and decided to open a new barangay for them to live in and develop. They consulted the Mayor of the Municipality of Cabarroguis about the matter and to their great delight; the desire of having a Barangay was created and was named Barangay Calaocan.

The name Calaocan is an Ilocano word means mixed because the residents are mixture of different tribes and of different beliefs, customs and traditions. These tribes were as follows: Ifugaos, Ibaloys and Bagos.

In 1973, Barangay Calaocan was then a full pledge Barangay of the Municipality of Cabarroguis under the Administration of Mayor Anastacio dele Pena, by virtue of Republic Act No. 5554 enacted by the Philippine Congress authored by then Honorable Senator Leonardo Perez. From that time on, many residential houses were built and sprouted like mushrooms because this barangay served as relocation of Ambuklao Dam in Mountain Province.


Now, Barangay Calaocan has six puroks and three sitios namely: taltal, little kapangan and little Banaue hills.

In order that cooperation and solidarity will reign in the place, devoted and energetic leaders were elected. The following were the seven Barangay Captains who have served diligently. Luis Lobyoc (1973-1978), Jose Pugongan (1978-1980), Marcos Bayeng(1980-1988), Marciano Immapa(1988-1992), Peter Tangid(1992-1997), Joaquin Pohnac(1997-2000), former Barangay Captain Marciano Immapa from year 2000 up to 2013, Captain Rufino C. Galian 2014-JUNE 2018 and the newly elected Punong Barangay Hon. Fernando M. Dango.

Having different tribes living in the Barangay was never a hindrance for progress because the people have common aspirations and goal that is progress through active, energetic and sincere leaders and followers.


In general, the level of effort which had brought about desirable performance or condition in the areas of Economic Development and Social Services has to be sustained.


#### **GENERAL SERVICES**

The PERSONAL SERVICES had an allotment of  $\underline{1,1158,180.00}$ . Among the sectors, it received the biggest share of 55% of the total budget. At the end of the year the actual collections is P  $\underline{2,602,261.59}$  while the actual expenditure is P  $\underline{2,491.856.75}$ 

On the other hand, the total picture of the fund utilization shows that the barangay incurred 2,491,856.75 expenses of its budget. Overall, it indicates a <u>110,404.84</u> savings.

Significantly, the barangay spent its financial resources hugely on personal services .







The barangay garnered an overall performance rating which denotes a performance level of 4 or a remarks of Compliant to the minimum requirements of the laws. Despite overcoming the rigorous processes in the implementation of the different policies and programs in the barangay, there are still several issues/deficiencies which need necessary improvement:

On Administration, where we have nine (9) services areas, it earned an average performance rating of 93 which denotes performace level of 4 compliants. This is attributed to the Barangay legislation, transparency, Citizen's participation, Development Planning, Revenue Code, Revenue Allocation and Utilization, Financial Accountability, Facilities and Customer Service and Human Resource Management and Development.


On Social Services, we obtained an average rating of 95 which indicates good performance. This is credited to the Health and Nutrition, Education, Culture and Sports, Women and Children, Public Safety and Disaster Risk Reduction Management.

On Economic Development, the barangay got an average rating of 82 or compliant which points out on the sustained effort of the barangay in sustaining the good practice in the governance.

Also rated is how the barangay faired in Environmental Management under the Service Areas of Natural Resources Management and Waste Management and Pollution Control where it garnered an average rating of 93. This is attributed to the compliant minimum requirement of the laws.

With the full cooperation of all sectors concerned, it paved the way towards the success of the year under review, CY 2023.





## 1. Administration

Barangay administration is one of the crucial and essential functions of the barangay. All local government units including the barangay need to undergo self-assessment to measure their performance in terms of delivery of services.

There are nine (9) sub areas which include Local Legislation, Transparency, Citizens' Participation, Development Planning, Revenue Generation, Revenue Allocation and Utilization, Financial Accountability, Facilities and Customer Service, and lastly Human Resource Development and Management.

#### LOCAL LEGISLATION

Legislation is the heart of governance. This is the foundation of effective implementation of laws which leads to a better management and development of the LGU.

One of the basic functions/roles of the Sanggunian is the enactment of ordinances and adoption of resolution. This process is called legislation. In order to formulate responsive ordinances/resolutions, there is a need to have proper structure and processes. A monitoring process is needed in order to check the implementation of ordinances.




# VI. Alternative Courses of Action
