Brief History of the Barangay

Barangay Gundaway come into existence in the year 1951, during the administration of late Silverio Pascua, who became first elected Municipal Mayor of Diffun, Gundaway was still then a part of Diffun.

On June 21, 1972, Republic Act 5554 becomes a Law, creating the Province of Quirino and the Municipality of Cabarroguis, and simultaneously Cabarroguis become the Capital town of Quirino. Gundaway then was transferred to Cabarroguis.

The land area of Barangay Gundaway is 629.6612 hectares with total population of 4,682 the first inhabitants of Barangay Gundaway were the families of late George Capinpin, Avelino Agustin Sr., Quirino Melchor, Manuel Abon, Dominador Licudan, Catalino Vertudez, Pedro Domondon, Faustino Flores while some came later. Although, Barangay Gundaway is hilly and mountainous, the soil is suited for agricultural purposes. The residents are mostly farmers. The main crops are: rice and corn while Banana and other kinds of vegetables are considered minor crops.

Barangay Gundaway which is the seat of the Capital Town also a promising ground for business, where we can now see different establishment. Barangay Gundaway has a biggest INTERNAL REVENUE ALLOTMENT entire the municipality of Cabarroguis, in additional to its local sources where officials used to run its Barangay Local Government Unit.

Barangay Gundaway has four (4) Elementary Schools and two (2) Secondary Schools. It has also a functional Health Center, managed by Barangay Health workers, Barangay Nutrition Scholars with supervision of Rural Health Midwife and NDPs.

Barangay Gundaway is a very peaceful place. Although the inhabitants belong to different creed of belief, considering they hail from the different parts of the adjacent provinces, like Ifugaos, Benguet, Pangasinenses, Tagalogs, Ibanags, Igorots and Ilocanos yet them exist still the camaraderie and brotherhood among the residents.

It is apparent that Barangay Gundaway will become a very progressive Barangay. The Barangay Officials are also in a double effort in the implementation of government projects. It has also the blessings of the local officials particularly the Honorable Congressman of the Province of Quirino and the Provincial Officials.

To date, the barangay Officials focus their attention to infrastructure project and Health and sanitation Programs.

II. Executive Summary

The State of Barangay Governance Report shows that the barangay's overall performance rating is 54% or equivalent to Performance Level of 3. The area of Environmental Management and Economic Development should be the top priority for development considering that the remarks are, it needs major reinforcement on barangay's compliance to the minimum requirements of the 1991 LGC and other laws to focus on the service areas of Waste Management and Pollution Control, Natural Resource Management, and Entrepreneurship, Business and Industry Promotion.

In general, the level of effort which had brought about desirable performance or condition in the areas of Administration and Social Services has to be sustained.

Problematic areas have to be given full consideration. Otherwise, the pace of development and change will be slowed down by the problems. Starting on the ensuing year, the following initiatives shall be pursued:

3. To enact Barangay Tax Ordinances with public hearing.

The Personal Services had an allotment of **2,956,224.00** (Identify the appropriations and the amount). Among the sectors, it received the biggest share of **55 %** of the total budget.

The barangay garnered an overall performance rating of 82% or a remark in which it meets the barangay's compliance to the minimum requirements of the 1991 LGC and other laws. Despite overcoming the rigorous processes in the implementation of the different policies and programs in the barangay, there are still several issues/deficiencies which need necessary improvement:

On Administration, where we have nine (9) service areas, it earned an average performance rating of 80% which indicates compliant to the minimum requirements of the 1991 LGC and other Laws. This is attributed to the barangay legislation, transparency, revenue allocation and utilization, facilities and customer service and human resource development and management;

On Social Services, we got an average rating of 88% or complaint to the minimum requirement of the 1991 LGC and other laws; needed prompt action/intervention to expedite the current performance level of the barangay, which ascribe in the dearth of Entrepreneurship, Business and Industry Promotion.

Also rated is how the barangay faired in Environmental Management under the Service Areas of Natural Resources Management and Waste Management and Pollution Control where it garnered an average rating of 0.76 %. This is attributed to the low score of the performance level of the said service areas.

With the full cooperation of all sectors concerned, it paved the way towards the success of the year under review, CY 2023.





IV. Report Findings

1. Administration

Barangay administration is one of the crucial and essential functions of the barangay. All local government units including the barangay need to undergo self-assessment to measure their performance in terms of delivery of services.

There are nine (9) sub areas which include Local Legislation, Transparency, Citizens' Participation, Development Planning, Revenue Generation, Revenue Allocation and Utilization, Financial Accountability, Facilities and Customer Service, and lastly Human Resource Development and Management.

➤ **LOCAL LEGISLATION**

Legislation is the heart of governance. This is the foundation of effective implementation of laws which leads to a better management and development of the LGU.

One of the basic functions/roles of the Sanggunian is the enactment of ordinances and adoption of resolution. This process is called legislation. In order to formulate responsive ordinances/resolutions, there is a need to have proper structure and processes. A monitoring process is needed in order to check the implementation of ordinances.

On Local, Barangay Gundaway needs minor reinforcement on barangay's minimum requirements of the 1991 LGC. The presence and implementation of its formulated Internal rules of procedure had guided the barangay officials in the proper and orderly conduct of Sanggunian sessions and official business transactions. It was adopted within the ninety-day period after it conducted its first session. The barangay hall has its designated session hall inside the barangay hall where the barangay officials conducted their regular Sangguniang barangay sessions and other official functions. It is likewise equipped with individual Sangguniang barangay Member's tables which were also utilized as their conference table. Chairs and gavel are also presented in the session hall.

The barangay officials conduct their two (2) regular sessions every month as reflected in the minutes of their regular meetings kept by the Barangay Secretary. Through this, they were able to discuss the issues and concerns affecting the community.

➤ **TRANSPARENCY**

Public trust should always be given premium/importance by the barangay officials. It is necessary that their constituents are informed and made aware of the operation of the barangay affairs. This is easily done if the barangay opens in all its transactions and operation to the public.

Barangay Gundaway submitted its Annual Report not later than March 31 of the ensuing year. It contained information on its actual state of local governance so that the LGU can address the issue in the succeeding year.

The barangay conducted the semesterly Barangay Assembly Day. It was during this activity that the Sangguniang Barangay Members reported their individual accomplishments based on their committee chairmanship. It also provided them the proper venue to present their plans and activities for the year. The barangay Treasurer likewise presented to the barangay assembly the FY 2022 Financial Status, Income and Expenditures with this, the constituents able to know about all revenues collected and funds received but it does not post in three (3) conspicuous places, this ascribe the 40% performance rating on transparency.



➤ **CITIZEN'S PARTICIPATION**

The involvement and participation of the different stakeholders is very important especially in voicing out their concerns and aspirations for the barangay. Their inputs are also vital during planning and formulation of laws.

Citizen's participation is one of the important aspects of governance. This is a manifestation that supreme power is lodged to the citizenry.

The administered BGPMS Data Capture Forms reveal the following information:

Of the 5 indicators, Barangay Gundaway obtained 4 indicators or remarks of 1.00%.

This was made possible by the effective leadership of the Punong Barangay and its Sangguniang Bayan Members to involve the Civil Society Organization and Peoples Organization in the planning, implementation and monitoring of different development projects of the organized barangay councils; hence, complying the requirement as provided in the Local Government Code 1991.





The conduct of semestral Barangay Assembly, allowed participation of the barangay assembly members to hear the semestral reports of the council and raise issues affecting the barangay and its constituents.

The Barangay had included the representative of Civil Society Organization in the barangay as members in the Barangay Development Council, Barangay Disaster Risk Management Council, Barangay Peace and Order Council and Barangay Council for Protection of Children. Their membership to these councils was reflected on the various barangay resolutions during the year. List of members of these BBIs and BDC were maintained by the secretary at the barangay hall. This had allowed their participation in the barangay development planning and ensured that the projects undertaken by the Barangay-based Institutions were responsive to the needs of barangay.

Barangay Gundaway had an organized Community Service Volunteers. They had undergone trainings (BPATS) to enhance their capacity in relation to the performance of their duties and functions in the barangay. This was conducted by the Philippine National Police in coordination with the Department of the Interior and Local Government

➤ **DEVELOPMENT PLANNING**

Barangay Officials and various sectoral representatives' work together to chart the future development of the barangay and address relevant problems and concerns affecting the community. It is in this activity where programs, projects and activities are identified and prioritized to ensure judicious utilization of the barangay funds.

Of the eight (8) indicators, our barangay only obtained 8 indicators or remarks of compliant to the minimum requirements of the 1991 LGC and other Laws.

On the Analysis Portion:

The average rate of 63% earned by our barangay is attributed to the indicators that we have or complied such as Organized Barangay Development Council, implemented the Barangay Development Plan, Prepared Barangay Development Plan integrating the Persons with Disabilities, Senior Citizens, Children, and Gender and Development, formulated Annual Investment Program, Developed/Updated the databases Registry of Barangay Inhabitants and Barangay Socio- Economic Profile. On the other hand, we lack 3 of the indicators which are the adopted measures/plans to prevent and control the proliferation of squatters and mendicants in the barangay, the creation of Barangay Development Council and we fail to conduct Barangay Development Council Meetings once at least every six months.

➤ **REVENUE GENERATION**

Laws/ordinances enacted/passed by the Sangguniang Barangay for the collection of taxes, fees and charges or generate revenues. RA 7160 allows the barangay to create provide other sources of funds for development projects that will benefit the barangay residents, subject to limitations as provided for by the law.

Results of the BGPMS Data Capture Form revealed the following:

Out of 5 indicators, our barangay garnered only 3 or an average rating of 60% implying a remark of needs minor reinforcement in regards to the Barangay compliance to the minimum requirements of the 1991 Local Government Code and other laws.

The result is attributed to the 3 indicators that we only have which are generated income from the Barangay Economic Enterprise, Updated Barangay Revenue Code, and Implemented Financial Management System following Commission on Audit (COA) Standards, and we failed to enact Barangay Tax Ordinance with public hearing in the preceding year and conducted Barangay Fund Raising Activity. The lacks must be do for the barangay's welfare.

➤ **REVENUE ALLOCATION AND UTILIZATION**

Compliance to mandatory budgetary allocations of barangay ensures that the vital service functions are funded and the priority development concerns of the Barangay are implemented.

Further, actual expenditure figures confirm whether the budgetary appropriation have been disbursed for the intended service functions

II. Social Services

The Barangay, although the smallest political unit, plays a very important role in the delivery of basic services to its constituents as provided for in the Local Government Code. There are three services under this performance area that determines if the barangay's program, project and activities are in harmony with the LGC. The 3 service areas are Health and Nutrition, Education, Culture and Sports and Peace, Security and Disaster Preparedness

➤ **HEALTH AND NUTRITION**

Health is wealth. This is the reason why most officials prioritize health and nutrition services. Although higher LGUs, such as the province and municipality, provide health and nutrition services, the barangay also is mandated to deliver basic health and nutrition services to its constituents.

RA 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2001 provides that local government units are responsible in implementing the provision of the law. Segregation and collection of waste is the responsibility of the barangay.

This is attributed to the 4 indicators that we failed to do and these are, Formulated Barangay Solid Waste Management Action Plan, Implemented Waste Segregation and Volume Control, Implemented Garbage Collection Scheme and Presence of Materials Recovery Facility in the Barangay.





Alternative Courses of Action

This portion sums up the courses of action which the Barangay has to undertake to address the problematic areas requiring decisive action on the indicators not complied by the **Barangay**.

Results/data showed our strengths under performance areas of Administration and Social Service particular on the service areas of Barangay Legislation and Health and Nutrition. On the other hand, the areas that need attention are under the performance areas of Economic

Development and Environmental Management particularly on the service areas of Entrepreneurship, Business and Industry and Natural Resource Management.


