AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE INFANT AND YOUNG CHILD FEEDING TASK FORCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CABARROGUIS

WHEREAS, one of the primordial concerns of the present administration is the health stability of the constituents especially the infant and young children;

WHEREAS, breastfeeding and proper complementary feeding are crucial in the early months and years of life of an individual as this could later result to a healthier and disease-free community;

WHEREAS, inappropriate feeding practices and their consequences are major obstacles to sustainable socioeconomic development and poverty reduction;

WHEREAS, the creation of the Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF) Task Force shall ensure the effective and efficient delivery of IYCF programs, plans and activities in the LGU.

NOW THEREFORE, I, AVELINO N. AGUSTIN, JR., Municipal Mayor of Cabarroguis, Quirino, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reorganization of the Infant and Young Child Feeding Task Force in the Municipality of Cabarroguis.

SECTION II. Duties and Functions

1. Raise public awareness on appropriate infant and young child feeding;
2. Identify the main problems affecting infant and young child feeding, determine approaches to their solution, and provide a framework of essential interventions;

3. Plan, provide, design, disseminate and regulate information related to infant and young child nutrition;
4. Oversee implementation of the Milk Code (Executive Order No. 51)
5. Monitor compliance as well as problems encountered in the implementation of the Milk Code;
6. Organize programs and activities for the promotion of proper breastfeeding and appropriate complementary feeding;
7. Ensure establishment and operation of breastfeeding room in the LGU and in the barangays;
8. Produce and distribute IEC materials on breastfeeding and proper complementary feeding;
9. Conduct evaluation and assessment on programs, plans and activities of IYCF;
10. Propose relative measures to the legislative department for legislation.

SECTION III. Effectivity

This Executive Order takes effect immediately.
