AN ORDER ORGANIZING THE LOCAL COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (LCPC) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CABARROGUIS

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7610, “Special Protection of Children Against Child Abuse, Exploitation and Discrimination Act” provides for stronger deterrence and special protection against child abuse, exploitation and discrimination and its corresponding penalties;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior Local Government (DILG) has issued several memorandum circulars to guide LGUs on the establishment of LCPC through the years;

WHEREAS, it is a common knowledge that the minors specifically those who belong to the less fortunate families are prone to abuse, exploitation and discrimination;

WHEREAS, the LCPC shall be the main conduit through which local stakeholders, including child-focused institutions and non government organizations and people’s and youth organizations are consulted and their meaningful participation ensured in the planning and implementation of interventions and programs for children.

NOW THEREFORE, I, AVELINO N. AGUSTIN, JR., Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Cabarroguis, Quirino, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the organization of Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC).

SECTION II. FUNCTIONS:

1. Formulate, develop, coordinate, monitor and review all local policies (to include BCPC prepared and issued policies), ordinances, plans, programs, and activities which shall promote the best interest and rights of children and ensure mainstreaming in the local development agenda;
2. Prepare an Annual Work and Financial Plan consistent with its functions as provided herein;
3. Establish, maintain and update a disaggregated database or local information system on all children within the municipality and shall include the information gathered;
4. Conduct advocacy activities on the promotion and protection of the rights and welfare of children including the development of information, education and advocacy materials;
5. Conduct capability-building activities for all stakeholders on children including the barangay level;
6. Provide assistance to children in need of special protection;
7. Document good practices on children; and
8. Conduct the Child-Friendly Local Governance Audit, through the LCPC Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force annually.

SECTION III. MEETINGS. The LCPC shall have regular quarterly meetings to be presided by the Chair or Vice-Chair

SECTION IV. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other orders, rules, regulations, and issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION V. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any part of this Order that is declared null and void shall not have any effect on the entirety of the Order.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
