



**Executive Order No. 042**  
*Series 2022*

**AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (MADAC) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CABARROGUIS, QUIRINO**

**Whereas**, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that Local Government Units shall pursue undertakings to improve public morals and maintain peace and order, and to protect the life, liberty and property of the people, among other equally significant concerns;

**Whereas**, Republic Act 9165 also known as the Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 provides that it is the policy of the State to safeguard the integrity of its territory and well-being of its citizenry particularly the youth on the harmful effect of dangerous drugs on their physical and mental well-being and to defend the same against acts or omissions detrimental to their development and preservation;

**Whereas**, the increasing use of illegal drugs has significantly contributed to the rise of criminality which necessitate a more aggressive and unified stance against illegal drugs to help ensure community peace and order and harmony;

**Whereas**, this problem can be address if all efforts of concerns agencies are coordinated in the fight against drugs to eliminate, if not totally eradicate, the problem;

**Whereas**, DILG memorandum Circulars 98-227, 99-230, 2001-90, 2003-131, 2015-63 and DILG-DDB JMC 2018-01, direct all local government units to organize their respective Local Anti-Drug Abuse Council, in furtherance of all government efforts to address the above-mentioned problem, and provide guidelines therefore;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, AVELINO N. AGUSTIN, JR.**, Municipal Mayor of this Municipality, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize the **Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council (MADAC)** of the Municipality of Cabarroguis;

**SECTION 1. COMPOSITION.** The **Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council(MADAC)** shall be composed of the following:

**SECTION 2. ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP.** – The ADAC Technical Working Group (TWG) shall prepare the LADPA, ensure its process of drafting is in conjunction with the preparation of the POPS Plan, Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP) and Local Development Investment Program (LDIP), and monitor and evaluate the implementation of PPSAs.

**2.1. Composition of the TWG.** – The ADAC TWG shall be composed of the following:

**SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS**

1. Serve as the focal point through which various organizations and individuals work together cooperatively in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of programs on drug abuse prevention;
2. Provide for an effective mechanism for the coordination of existing services and programs and those which might be developed in the immediate future;
3. Provide a mechanism to obtain funds, volunteer facilities and technical expertise;
4. Conduct information and education campaign on the ill effects of illegal drugs, monitor and report to proper authorities, drug pushers, and drug users in the locality;
5. Prepare a confidential watch list of drug user and pushers found in the LGU's area of jurisdiction to be submitted to the PNP Anti-Illegal Drugs Task Force for the latter's validation or verification leading to the arrest and filing of appropriate charges;
6. Perform other related responsibilities as may be assigned by competent authorities.

**SECTION 4. SECRETARIAT**

The Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council Secretariat shall be designated by the Mayor. The secretariat shall handle the administrative and technical activities of the Council and it shall also undertake liaisoning and coordination of activities with appropriate agencies of the government.

Moreover, the secretariat shall be assisted in its functions and duties by the regular staff of the Council Chairperson.

**SECTION 5. CONFIRMING THE MEMBERS OF THE CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs)**

Cognizant of the importance of CSOs in the socio-economic development of the Municipality and their membership to local special bodies such as the Local Anti-Drug Abuse Council, the following CSOs are hereby confirmed to be members of this body:
